At the end of each school year, the students receive the internationally recognized certificates of the European school system.

How? Come? Wie?

Children who turn six years old no later than the 1st of September and meet the admission criteria may be admitted to grade 1 of our school.

The admission procedure consists of an orientation interview to determine linguistic flexibility and creativity, motivation and social maturity and an interview with the parents or guardians. In this meeting, the choice of the respective language section is also agreed upon.

Following the orientation meeting, the school management will make a decision on the student's acceptance into our program.

The deadlines for enrolment in year 1 will be published at an appropriate time on our website. An application for admission from families coming to Tyrol at a later date can be submitted throughout the school year.

As in all Austrian schools, students with special learning needs are supported by comprehensive pedagogical support measures.
